Eight things you didn't know about our food system

Over the following weeks we will be looking at aspects from CAFOD' *Fix the Food System* campaign so we are better informed.

4. Millions of people who produce our food are living in poverty themselves

Around 800 million people go hungry each day and the majority of them are those who grow the world's food. Three-quarters of people facing hunger in the world are living in rural areas and most of them depend on agriculture for their livelihood. 25 per cent of people in Africa are affected by hunger – the continent with the highest proportion.

Of course, hunger is an issue in the UK too, with 9 per cent of adults experiencing food insecurity in January 2022.
