## Finance matters ... in both parishes

**Diocesan levy**. Each year the diocese levies the parish in order to fund central operations. This year, the rate of levy on offertory income remains unchanged at 24.70%, and the rate on rental income, including qualifying hall income, also remains unchanged at 20% of gross rental income received.

For Garstang, the levy this year is £10987.81, and for Scorton £2667.83.
