If you are interested, the first step is to register on this matching portal https://www.homesforukraine.org.uk/. The second step is to register with the Government: https://homesforukraine.campaign.gov.uk/

This will allow safety checks on prospective hosts and their accommodation. Sponsors will provide accommodation for a minimum of six months and currently a maximum of 12 months. The Government is offering an optional 'thank you' payment of £350 per month.

You will be encouraged to know that the diocese is looking into ways that diocesan property might be used to help the situation.
