## Season of Advent: Sunday 1B **General Intercessions**

## **Priest**

God of hosts, bring us back; let your face shine on us and we shall be saved. In this season of hope, let us pray for the Church and for the world.

## Reader

1. For the Church: that we may respond to God's word and let its message guide us as we begin the Season of Advent.

**PAUSE** for silent prayer — at least **five** seconds. Repeat after each intention.

Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.

- For those who have wandered from their relationship with God; 2. that the memories and hopes of this season will open a doorway to God, who loves them.
- 3. For all who are suffering from violence, famine, persecution or neglect; that God will destroy the bonds that hold them and open the door of mercy and compassion for them.
- 4. For all who are ill; that God will heal the sick, give strength to those who care for them, and guide all who are working on the vaccines.
- For all who are awaiting the birth of a child; 5. that God will bless these expectant parents, ill their hearts with love, and help their children to grow and mature.
- 6. For the faithful departed and those who mourn; that the hope of Christ our Saviour will shine in their hearts.
- Let us ask our Blessed Mother to take our prayers to Jesus her Son: Hail, Mary, ... 7.

## **Priest**

Rend the heavens and come down, O God of all the ages! Rouse us from sleep, deliver us from our heedless ways, and form us into a watchful people, that, at the advent of your Son, he may find us doing what is right, mindful of all you command. Grant this through Jesus Christ our Lord.
