Reader

 For all who are united to Christ in baptism, that the Church may be a beacon of hope, shining in the world.

PAUSE for silent prayer — at least **five** full seconds. Repeat after each intention.

Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.

- 2. For governments, and all who serve in politics; that the feast of Christ's birth will inspire them to strive for justice and peace on earth.
- For refugees and victims of natural disaster; for those who are homeless, or who endure poor housing.
- For those who will spend Christmas alone, through illness, separation, after the death of a loved one, or because they have lost touch with family and friends.
- We call to mind those who are prevented from celebrating this Christmas Mass with us: those who are housebound or isolating, and all who are ill.
- We commend to God the souls of all the faithful departed: those who have died recently, all who have died over this past year, and those whose anniversary we keep.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of our Saviour, to join her prayers to ours: Hail, Mary ...
