- 4. At this harvest season we pray for our farmers and for all who work in food production; may we always have enough for our own needs, and to share with others.
- 5. For all who are suffering from, or are bereaved as a result of Covid 19: we pray that God's healing hand may rest upon them; we pray too, for all doctors, nurses and support staff.
- 6. For all who have died: may they experience the peace of Christ eternally.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of Our Lord, to intercede for us in these troubling times: Hail, Mary....
