may they be sustained by the knowledge that the Lord holds them in the palm of his hand.

- 6. For all who have died, especially those in our parish: may they be led by the Light of Christ into the joy of God's presence.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to join her prayers with ours: Hail, Mary ...
