- 4. For all who feel trapped by fear or anxiety: may God free their hearts, and help them live in the assurance of his abiding love.
- 5. For all who are ill in mind or body: may they have an awareness of God's presence, and have confident hope in his love for them.
- 6. For all who have died, that God will welcome them to his eternal banquet; and for all who are grieving the death of a loved one, that God will wipe away their tears, heal their pain, and give them peace; this Sunday, we pray especially for all who lost their lives in the two World Wars and in subsequent conflicts.
- 7. Let us ask Mary, Mother of our Risen Lord, to intercede for us: Hail, Mary, ...
