Priest

Christ the Lord is a priest for ever.

In his name, we pray for the Church and the world.

Reader

1. For all members of the Church; that we may share the eucharist with deep and reverent faith.

PAUSE for silent prayer — at least **five** seconds, please. Repeat after each intention.

Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.

- 2. For all who serve the mystery of the eucharist: bishops and priests who preside, deacons and those who minister holy communion whether at Mass, in hospital, or in people's homes.
- 3. For all who help the Church to reflect on the mystery of the eucharist: theologians, those who compose prayers and hymns; teachers and catechists; may their gifts lead us deeper into the paschal mystery.
- 4. For all who are deprived of the sacrament of the eucharist, whether through oppression, illness, or the lack of a priest; may they still know the presence of their Saviour.
- 5. For the hunger of the world; that all who suffer lack of food, water, clothing, shelter, or health care, may find the members of Christ's body to be generous neighbours.
- 6. For the faithful departed, who were nourished by the eucharist in this life; that they will be counted among those invited to the banquet of the Lamb.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to join her prayers with ours: Hail, Mary ...
