## **General Intercessions**

### **Priest**

#### Reader

1. For Mark and Peter, whom we have welcomed today as one of us; that they may have the help and guidance of the Holy Spirit to persevere faithfully in the choice they have made.

**PAUSE** for silent prayer — at least five seconds, please. Repeat after each intention. Lord, in your mercy. **Hear our prayer.** 

- 2. For all who believe in Christ, and for the Communities to which they belong, that they may come to perfect unity.
- 3. For the Church in which Mark and Peter were baptised and received their formation as Christians, that it may always grow in knowledge of Christ and proclaim him more effectively.
- 4. For all in whom the spark of desire for God already burns, that they may be led to the fullness of truth in Christ.
- 5. For those who do not yet believe in Christ the Lord, that they may enter the way of salvation by the light of the Holy Spirit.
- 6. For all people, that they may be freed from hunger and war and live in peace and tranquillity.
- 7. For ourselves, that as we have received the gift of faith, so too we may persevere in it to the end of our lives.
- 8. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to join her prayers with ours: Hail, Mary, ...
