What is the human race that God should care for us?
Yet the Spirit empowers us to pray in the name of Jesus Christ
with the confidence of those who know that God will hear our prayer.

Reader

1. For Jews, Christians, and Muslims who all believe in the one true God;
that God's holy wisdom will direct us in the ways of peace.

PAUSE for silent prayer — at least five seconds, please. Please repeat after each intention.

Lord, in your mercy. **Hear our prayer.**

2. For our diocese, our parish, and all who worship with us this weekend;
that the Holy Spirit will renew our faith,
and inspire us to bear faithful and fruitful witness to Christ.
3. For governments, and all who serve in public office;
that they will have a zeal for justice and a care for the common good.
4. For all who are sitting examinations, or now awaiting results,
especially the members of our own parishes;
that God's wisdom will protect and guide them.
5. For all who are ill, whether at home, in hospital, the hospice,
or one of the care homes;
for anyone who has asked for our prayers.
6. For all who have died;
that they will enjoy the fullness of life with the Blessed Trinity;
for all who mourn,
that they will know the comfort of the One true God.
7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Church, to join her prayers with ours: Hail, Mary ...

you revealed the wonderful mystery of the Godhead
by sending into the world
the Word who speaks all truth
and the Spirit who makes us holy.

Grant that we may proclaim the fullness of faith
by acknowledging and worshipping
three persons, eternal in glory,
