**Lent Devotions – Stations of the Cross** – During Lent this year some of our parishioners, as individuals or on behalf of various groups, will be leading the Stations, **each Friday at 7.00pm**. Please do come along to join in this special devotion.

**Catholicism DVDs (Garstang)** – After the positive response to the showing of some of this series of films and discussions in Advent it was suggested that we could continue with more in the same series each week during Lent. Bishop Robert Barron introduces and comments on the subject in a very engaging style. The first showing will be on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> February, at approximately 7.30pm, immediately after the Stations of the Cross. **All are very welcome.**

**The Rededication of England as Mary's Dowry - 29<sup>th</sup> March 2020** – In 1381, England was dedicated to Mary by King Richard II and was 'set apart' for her among the nations. This year, the Christians of England are called to make a personal dedication to Mary, taking up her example as Christ's first disciple. History shows us that when the people pray a surrender to God's will for their lives, society is transformed. By taking up this personal dedication in 2020, you can be a part of the renewal of this nation, drawing ourselves closer to the will of our loving God, through Mary. Cardinal Vincent Nicholls says, *“There is much for us to learn about being the Dowry of Mary and the love expressed in that title. It is rich in history even if not contemporary in language. I hope we can use these coming weeks to deepen our knowledge of this ancient and lovely*

*devotion”*. A link providing more information on this great occasion and what we can do to be involved has been put on our parish website.

**LiveSimply** – Pope Francis, speaking at the World Economic Forum, encouraged us to *“Listen to the cry of the earth and the cry of the poor who suffer most”*. Bishop Paul in his January Blog followed on from this when he said *“There is renewed encouragement to adopt healthier, less wasteful habits now. Personal discipline is such hard work though! Why bother? The bottom line is, because Jesus did it. That'll do me.”* We are invited to consider the 6Rs for sustainability. For March, we will focus on this first of these: **Rethink**. Do you ever think about how much plastic you use on a daily basis? How about how much rubbish you generate each week? The first step in the 6Rs is to stop and think about what you are buying and using. Is it something you need? Is there a way to reduce your waste or change your habits? **Church sound system Garstang** - Some improvements to the microphones have already been carried out: the new lectern mic will better serve readers of different height and is more discrete; the antennas for the radio mics are now in church rather than in the sacristy, and are no longer compromised by the thick stone walls. We will also improve the loop system to reduce background noise and give a more constant and consistent output. This work will be carried out later this month, at a cost of £5,000.
