<u>Coronavirus: instructions from our Bishop</u> The Bishop has issued the following instructions, effective 5-21 March, and to be reviewed.

The sign of peace at Mass is suspended: rather than shake hands or kiss, I suggest that we simply turn to one another and say, "Peace be with you."

Holy Communion from the chalice is suspended.

Receiving the Consecrated Bread, the Host. The Bishop encourages everyone to receive Communion in the hand rather than on the tongue, as an act of loving charity to our community. Holy Water stoups are to be emptied. High contact surfaces. In our churches, we are asked to clean door handles, light switches, etc thoroughly and regularly. Ministers of Communion will sanitise their hands before and after distributing Holy Communion. We will begin this practice in our parishes as soon as we can source the high-alcohol sanitiser. (Anti-bacterial gel is ineffective on the virus.) Hymnbooks and missals. We might not be able to avoid using shared hymnbooks and missals altogether, but please pick up your own copies so that folk are not having to hand them out. Finally, our own personal responsibility: for the good of all, and especially those among us most at risk, everyone, please wash your hands thoroughly and regularly in hot soapy water, use tissues in which to sneeze or cough. If you have a noticeable cough or cold, it might well not be Coronavirus but, at this time especially, it can be unsettling for those around you in church: stay at home. Please pray for all who are ill with the virus, all medical staff, and those working in medical research. Thank you, Fr Geoffrey.
