Works in our parish cemetery

Work to installing drainage, paths, and the concrete plinths for the headstones is making great progress.

The cost of this work is £20,000; and having spent £110,000 repairing and renovating the church tower, we are short of funds indeed.

May I appeal to parishioners for funds to pay for the work in the cemetery? I'm all too aware that, with the increase in the cost of living, fuel, and all the rest, this is hardly a good time to be asking folk for significant money.

Perhaps forty parishioners – individuals, couples, families – might be able to donate £500. That would cover the £20,000, and I am willing to be one of these donors myself. If you are able to Gift Aid your donation, all the better. Many thanks for the donations received already: £11,500.
