## Easter Triduum : Resurrection of the Lord: Easter Morning General Intercessions

## **Priest**

Giving thanks to God, who draws us into the mystery of his Son's death and resurrection, we bring before God the needs of the Church and of the world.

## Reader

 For the communion of the Church; that, in union with Francis our pope and our bishops, we may bear joyful and courageous witness to our risen Lord.

**PAUSE** for silent prayer — at least **five** seconds, please. Repeat after each intention. Lord, in your mercy. **Hear our prayer.** 

- 2. For those reborn this Easter by water and the Holy Spirit; and those who celebrate their full membership of the Catholic Church. that together we will walk in newness of life as God's adopted children.
- 3. For governments and all who serve in public office; may they know the wisdom of God, so that harmony, justice, and peace may flourish; we pray especially for all the peoples of the Holy Land.
- 4. For all who are ill and those who have care of them; for the injured and the disabled, those who suffer mental ill-health, and those whose well-being has been weakened or destroyed; that they may know the presence and power of the risen Christ.
- 5. For the members of our parish, and all our guests and visitors; that we will grow together in the Easter faith we celebrate this day, and bear fruitful witness to our Risen Lord.
- 6. For all who have touched and graced our lives, and have gone before us in faith; we remember our fellow parishioners, our friends, and members of our own families; that they will rest in peace and rise in glory.
- 7. We ask Mary, Mother of the Risen Christ, to join her prayers with ours: Hail Mary
