<u>"Fairtrade under threat"</u> – We have received a letter from CAFOD about Sainsbury's Supermarket's decision to remove the Fairtrade Mark from some of their most popular own-brand tea, and to pilot their own 'Fairly Traded' scheme instead. Now the pilot phase of Sainsbury's 'Fairly Traded' tea is over; they said that their approach would not leave

farmers out of pocket and that it would have more positive outcomes, such as allowing increased investment in enhanced environmental measures. CAFOD want them to prove that they were right, and asks them about the impacts on the lives of farmers and producers. There was news in April that Sainsbury's hopes to buy ASDA, to become the largest supermarket in the UK, and CAFOD hopes very much that Sainsbury's will keep its commitment to Fairtrade in this move. At the back of church there are copies of a letter written to Sainsbury's, asking how their pilot has impacted on the lives of producers. Please would you consider supporting Fairtrade by signing a copy and handing it in to your local Sainsbury's store? *Thank you*
