Last weekend we ran our Annual Training Day, on Saturday, for all the volunteers involved in this year's holidays. Then on Sunday we ran a trip for 100 people to The Children's Adventure Farm in Cheshire, for the children and volunteers who will be attending one of our holidays in the summer. We are now getting on with arranging our three annual summer holidays for children with a range of disabilities and additional needs. We are just in the process of commissioning a new website and will put the address in the bulletin once it is up and running to give you all a chance of keeping up with what we do. They are taking 350kg of resources with them, which, together with chemicals and equipment ordered in Uganda, comes to a total of £13,000. They could not have done this without the support of Our Lady's Catholic College in Lancaster, local parishes and businesses.
